Revive the lost organ of the Basilica of Notre-Dame

The Basilica of Notre-Dame is one of the oldest shrines of the city of Fribourg (Switzerland). It has undergone an overall renovation that lasted for 20 years and ended in 2011.



The Basilica has been revived. Let us give her back her organ:

an instrument in accordance with the building's long history,

in accordance with the spiritual life of the city,

in accordance with the spectacular architecture of the Basilica.

The Board of the Foundation of the Basilica has entrusted the project to the organ manufacturer Blumenroeder, Alsace (France), who will build an instrument using the techniques of the famous Alsatian organ builder Jean-André Silbermann (1712-1783). The organ, designed in accordance with the size and acoustics of the Basilica and fitting in with its decoration, will enhance the importance and the reputation of the Basilica.

The Board has entrusted the Organ Commission with the management of the project and the Association of Friends of the Basilica of Notre-Dame with the financial campaign. The amount needed is CHF 880'000.

Financing will depend mainly on private donations.
